The aim of the grants program is to award financial assistance to support young people achieving their individual goals.

Grants are available for young people who are residents of the City of Marion.

Applications will be received from 1 July to 30 June each financial year or until funds are exhausted.

#### Eligibility Criteria

#### To be eligible, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be a resident of the City of Marion
- Aged 12-25 years at the time of the event
- Representation at events/activities within Australia or internationally (including peak body organised event)
- If your field does not have a peak body, please attach a letter of invitation or relevant supporting documentation

- Applications must include a letter of verification from the relevant peak body or a letter of invitation with the applicant's name, event details and date
- Applicants will be notified within four weeks of submitting an application
- Successful applications will receive payment via EFT. If applicants are under 18 the EFT will be made to the parent/guardian.
